- Establish a culture of support for students, staff and community utilising well being initiatives.
- Implementation of Positive Behaviour for Learning processes with fidelity and consistency.
- Co-teaching across the school enables shared responsibility for the success of all students through developing teacher knowledge and expertise to include and engage all learners.
