Our initiatives include


- Supporting teachers to focus on improving learning for each individual student through innovative curriculum approaches and reflective pedagogical practices.

- Provide additional support for students through the implementation of our Diverse Learner's plan.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Employing a HOD-Curriculum 0.8 FTE | \$120,000 |
| • Partially funding our intensive teaching team 0.2 FTE | \$23,000 |
| • Supporting teacher planning with PLC and time | \$28,000 |
| • Supporting initiatives to increase student attendance | \$22,500 |
| • Providing teacher aide time for tier 3 support | \$20,779 |
| • Providing support for well being projects | \$10,000 |
| • Funding PBL support processes | \$11,500 |
